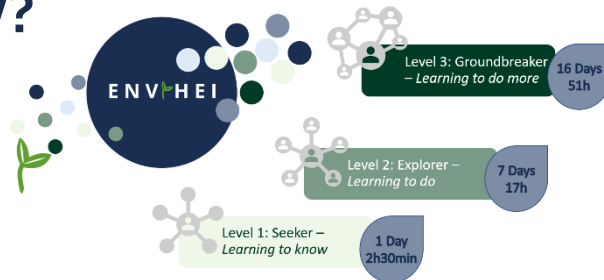

Professional Development Program (PDP)

The ENVIHEI PDP trains educators to integrate sustainability and green competences into higher education through active, student-centered methods. It combines online sessions with practical implementation during the Winter School.

Winter School

The ENVIHEI Winter School (23–28 February 2026, Leoben, Austria) brings together students and educators to tackle real sustainability challenges using problem-based, student-centered learning. It builds on an online training phase and provides hands-on experience, with all outputs shared as Open Educational Resources.
